It does not restrict its remit to any particular methodological or theoretical orientation.

Papers should not exceed 8,000 words in length, including notes. Longer papers will be considered only under special circumstances.

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Authors are required to submit electronically for all submissions of the manuscripts through the website of DergiPark by clicking on "Online Submission" above.

### Preparing Your Manuscript for Submission

The article should be written in Cambria, 12 pt and 1,5 line spacing and justified.

Articles must not exceed 8000 words; reviews must not exceed 1500 words. Fieldwork reports should be between 500 to 2000 words. All document formats must be sent in DOC or DOCX.

*Musicologist* adheres to the APA reference style. View the Musicologist Reference Style to ensure your manuscript conforms to this reference style.
